# Cape Cod



*Located in the easternmost region of Massachusetts, a mere 75 miles south of Boston, this 70 mile long sandy peninsula is distinguished by more than 300 miles of coast lined with endless soft sand beaches. Its signature gable-roof shingled houses, buffed by the constant ocean breezes to a soft grey, add to the special feeling of this truly magical area.*

*Cape Cod ... it's much more than summer sun and fun.*

*Join your host, Brian Jackson, on this third annual fall getaway and explore the "storybook island" of Martha's Vineyard, the Newport mansions, summer homes of America's most wealthy, and Sandwich, the areas oldest town and world renowned for its 19<sup>th</sup> century glass.*

## **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 12, 2010**

An early departure this morning from the KW area on your way by motorcoach to West Springfield, MA and check into the HAMPTON INN for a one night stay.

A WELCOME RECEPTION will be held in your honor upon arrival.

DINNER is included this evening at a local restaurant.

## **WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 13, 2010**

BREAKFAST is included this morning at your hotel. Travel to CAPE COD.

Welcome to the sandy shores of CAPE COD. Extending some 70 miles into the sea, the Cape is home to both natural beauty and quaint colonial villages. You will meet your LOCAL GUIDE and travel to SANDWICH – the oldest town on Cape Cod. You will view the Village Green, the Great Salt Marsh, a Cranberry Bog, and Cape Cod Bay. Sandwich became the site of one of America's largest glass factories, an industry that flourished during the 19<sup>th</sup> century. This quaint and quiet seaside community is the hometown of Thornton Burgess, naturalist and author of 170 children's books. Enjoy lunch on your own in the downtown area. Included today is admission to THE SANDWICH GLASS MUSEUM. Enjoy viewing sparkling exhibits that describe the transformation of a small farming community into one of the world's most respected manufacturers of 19<sup>th</sup> century glass. Watch molten glass, drawn from the furnace, blown and pressed into exquisite shapes and visit the distinctive museum shop. Travel further down Cape and your guide will conduct a tour of HYANNIS including the John F. Kennedy Memorial, the Korean War Memorial, Hyannisport and a view of St. Francis Xavier Church, the summer parish of the Kennedy Family. (Please remember that this is an active house of worship and there will be certain times that we cannot enter the sanctuary.) When your touring for the day is complete your guide will take you to THE CAPE POINT HOTEL. Enjoy a Special Evening of DINNER and ENTERTAINMENT at Alberto's Ristorante.

### **THURSDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2010**

BREAKFAST is included this morning at your hotel. Your LOCAL GUIDE will meet you at your hotel and will escort you to the HY-LINE DOCKS for ticketing and boarding of the 9:30 am HIGH SPEED ferry to the island of MARTHA'S VINEYARD. Upon arrival at 10:25 am you will board a local bus for a "DOWN ISLAND" TOUR. You will learn about the history and lifestyles of the islanders as you pass through the picturesque villages. There will be free time for lunch and shopping in the historic whaling town of Edgartown. Complete your day on the island in Oak Bluffs strolling through "Cottage City" with its brightly painted cottages and decorative "gingerbread" trim. Departure back to Hyannis is scheduled for 4:25 pm, arriving on the mainland at 5:20 pm.

LOBSTER DINNER is included this evening back on the mainland. An alternate entrée will be available for any "landlubbers" not wishing to eat shellfish.

### **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2010**

BREAKFAST is included this morning at your hotel. Your LOCAL GUIDE will meet you at your hotel and you will travel to the CITY OF BOSTON. Boston is the city where America's roots were formed and driving through it is like reading the pages of an American history book. Your guide will point out sights along the Freedom Trail as well as the Boston Common and Public Gardens, the Back Bay, Beacon Hill, and the gold-domed State House. You will view the U.S.S. Constitution and see the Bunker Hill Monument. Enjoy a BOX LUNCHEON before attending the 1:30 pm performance of the BOSTON SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA at Symphony Hall. DINNER is included this evening in downtown Boston before returning to your hotel.

### **SATURDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2010**

BREAKFAST is included this morning at your hotel. This morning you pack, check out and travel to NEWPORT, RI where your LOCAL GUIDE will meet you. Enjoy the charm of Newport's historic buildings and restored homes on this narrated tour covering over 150 points of interest. Take in the rugged beauty of Ten-Mile Ocean Drive and the fabulous mansions along tree-lined Bellevue Avenue. Admission to the BREAKERS MANSION will be included. History buffs and dreamers of the Gilded Age and the Great Gatsby days will be astounded by The Breakers which was built for Cornelius Vanderbilt and styled after a northern Italian Palazzo. It contains 72 rooms, many of them unequalled for magnificence in the United States. In the mid afternoon you will travel to Sturbridge, MA and will check into the STURBRIDGE HOST HOTEL for a one night stay. DINNER is included this evening at the hotel. Enjoy a complimentary glass of wine with dinner to toast the ending of your wonderful Symphony trip to Massachusetts.

### **SUNDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2010**

BREAKFAST is included this morning at your hotel before boarding your bus for your trip back to Canada. Travelling homeward, you will have time to enjoy the beauty of the fall scenery and savour the wonderful memories of your Cape Cod holiday.
